Tunisian Space Invader arm warmers! Beginner level

To try Tunisian crochet before I start a bigger project, I made some very simple arm warmers. You can crochet it according to the following template or just omit the thumb-hole and close one side to get a cell phone case, for example.



Yarn: Red Heart Lisa in 2 Colours

Hook: 4mm

ch = chain A= Colour 1 B= Colour 2

35 ch A

- 1. 34st A
- 2. 34st A
- 3. 34st A
- 4. 34st A
- 5. 4st A, 1st B, 2st A, 2st B, 27st A = 34st
- 6. 5st A, 1st B, 1st A, 3st B, 24st A = 34st
- 7. 4st A, 1st B, 1st A, 2st B, 1st A, 2st B, 23st A = 34st
- 8. 5st A, 1st B, 1st A, 5st B, 22st A = 34st
- 9. 5st A, 1st B, 1st A, 5st B, 22st A = 34st
- 10. 4st A, 1st B, 1st A, 2st B, 1st A, 2st B, 23st A = 34st
- 11. 5st A, 1st B, 1st A, 3st B, 24st A = 34st
- 12. 4st A, 1st B, 2st A, 2st B, 27st A = 34st
- 13.-32. 34st A

32 rows fit my hands, depending on your hand size, you might need more or less rows.

If you want to adapt it to your cell phone, simply vary the chain and the rows. Sew it together and don't forget the thumb-hole. This is the arm warmer for your right hand.

For the left hand:

- 20. 5st A, 1st B, 1st A, 3st B, 24st A = 34st
- 21. 4st A, 1st B, 1st A, 2st B, 1st A, 2st B, 23st A = 34st
- 22. 5st A, 1st B, 1st A, 5st B, 22st A = 34st
- 23. 5st A, 1st B, 1st A, 5st B, 22st A = 34st
- 24. 4st A, 1st B, 1st A, 2st B, 1st A, 2st B, 23st A = 34st
- 25. 5st A, 1st B, 1st A, 3st B, 24st A = 34st
- 26. 4st A, 1st B, 2st A, 2st B, 27st A = 34st
- 27.-32. 34st A

- 20. 4st A, 1st B, 1st A, 4st B, 24st A = 34st
- 21. 7st A, 1st B, 1st A, 2st B, 23st A = 34st
- 22. 6st A, 6st B, 22st A = 34st
- 23. 6st A, 6st B, 22st A = 34st
- 24. 7st A, 1st B, 1st A, 2st B, 23st A = 34st
- 25. 4st A, 1st B, 1st A, 4st B, 24st A = 34st
